### **Report of Police Chief Shane Nolley:**

Chief Shane Nolley reported for the month of November 2019, there were 353 calls for service. Hours worked were as followed: Chief Nolley-152 regular, 8 overtime; Officer Stephens-150 regular, 10.50 overtime; Officer Brady 119 regular, 10 overtime; Officer Dawson-156 regular, 11 overtime, Officer Thompson – 96.75 regular, 0 overtime, Officer Wynn-76.25 regular, 8 overtime. There were 0 Traffic Crash Report, and 25 Offense Reports. Arrest Information: Arrests - 10, Traffic Citations - 14, and Warning Citations - 39. Police vehicle information: Unit 1 – 2017 Police Interceptor – 1,437 miles driven, Unit 2 - 2005 Ford Explorer – 696 miles driven, Unit 3 - 2015 Police Interceptor – 1,075 miles driven. Repairs: \$1,229.68 and Training: \$0.
